"It was more simple and intimate than her first [to Trey in season three], but it still had Charlotte's ultimate level of elegance," says *Sex* production designer Jeremy Conway of the 150-guest affair that took four weeks to create. Inspired by Jacqueline Bouvier's 1953 wedding to John F. Kennedy, the *Sex* team used everything from candles to crystal to lilies of the valley (*six* pricey bridal bouquets were necessary, since the flowers are quick to wilt). Not that the bride would settle for less. *Sex* executive producer Cindy Chupack tells *Us*, "Charlotte wanted a grand affair since she felt like this time, she was marrying for life." **US**
